The purpose of the work sessions was to discuss future plans for the park property. A plan for future development of the park was previously submitted, approximately seven years ago by the Park Committee Members and approved by the Chester County Conservation District. Charlie participated in Penn Dot's audit of Route 10 and they prefer no new entrances onto the highway, so he would like to move the park entrance to Catamount Road. Another subject discussed was funding. We have not budgeted anything in the past few years. Some members mentioned that maybe we should just plan for a pavilion at this time or maybe a soccer field or walking trails and gradually develop the area. It was decided that the Park Committee Members would meet again on Monday, May 21, 2012 at 7:00 PM to walk the property. The Supervisors were invited to join in this walk. The Secretary will check with the Solicitor to inquire about charging a small fee for park rentals. Other ideas were to invite interested people to serve on the committee.
